Building accessible learning and communication programs

What EduLinked does

- We work with people and communities to make learning fair.
- We listen to people with lived experience when we design our programs.
- We make learning tools that are easy to use and welcoming for everyone — including people with learning difficulties, older people, and low-literacy learners.

Together we create safe learning spaces where people can build confidence and practical skills.



How we do it

- We use the EduLinked Modular Learning System (EMLS) — short, flexible workshop modules.
- We build hands-on experiences like the Spatial Learning Node to show ideas in new ways.
- We make an Inclusion Greeter — a friendly, AAC-friendly reception guide.
- We train people through the Certified EduLinked Facilitator (CEF) pathway so programs are delivered well.



Who we work with (partners)

We work with:

- Schools
- Libraries and councils
- Disability and community services
- Training providers and youth services

Partners help by giving a room, telling people about the program, and supporting participants if they need help. We also share simple, anonymous results so partners can see how the program helps.



What participants gain

Participants may get:

- Practical ways to communicate and be heard
- More confidence to speak or show ideas
- Simple strategies to speak up for themselves (self-advocacy)
- New ways to learn with multi-sensory tools

These supports help people with learning difficulties, older people and people with low literacy as well as people who use AAC.

The tools and skills can be used after the workshop.
