Plain language summary

- Read the program information.
- Share plain-language information with the young person.
- Check if the young person is interested.
- Ask permission before sharing details.

- Contact EduLinked.

What to share

- Preferred name.
- Age range.
- Contact preference.
- Broad access preferences.
- Interest area.

What not to send

- Do not send diagnosis reports, medical history, NDIS plans, school records, case notes, photos, videos or media files unless EduLinked asks through a secure process.
