- Keeping evidence organised.
- Making support conversations less overwhelming.

How to use it

- 1 Write your main goal in plain language.
- 2 List what is working now.
- 3 List what is hard now.
- 4 Write the supports you use and the supports you may need.
- 5 Bring your questions to a trusted support person or relevant professional.

Privacy and access

- Only share personal information with people you trust.
- Store documents safely.
- Ask for communication support if forms or meetings are hard to understand.
- Request Easy Read, large print or other access adjustments where needed.
